The Rector of the University of Yaounde II announces that:

A Master's degree in Political Science, option International Relations, specialization "Francophonie and Globalization" is offered at the International Relations Institute of Cameroon (IRIC) for the academic year 2020-2021, this is within the framework of the Senghor Chair in Francophonie and Globalization of the University of Yaounde II. This is a delocalized Master's degree (French diploma from the University Jean Moulin Lyon III). Number of places of thirty-five (35).

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Be of Cameroonian or other nationality ;
- Hold at least a Bachelor's degree in Law and Political Science, Economics, Information and Communication Sciences, Humanities or any other university degree recognized as equivalent by the Ministry of Higher Education;
- Submit a brief letter of motivation or a proven interest in Francophonie and Globalization studies.

Each application must include the following documents:

- 01 certified copy of birth certificate less than three (03) months old ;
- 01 certified copy of the highest diploma with transcripts, signed by the competent academic authorities ;
- 01 curriculum vitae;
- 01 photo 4 x 4
- 01 certificate of non-conviction less than three (03) months old ;
- 01 Receipt of payment of Twenty Five Thousand (25,000) F CFA representing the costs of studying the file, non-refundable expenses on account no. 11507243152- 01 entitled IRIC-Concours/Chaire Senghor at the SCB, Agence du 20 Mai opposite MINESUP

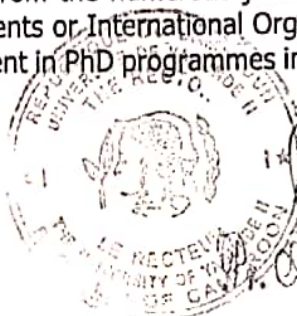
NB: The payment of these fees is subject to the issuance of a clearance by IRIC's steward/revenue administrator after verification of the file by the Chair's officials.

The selection of candidates will be made on the basis of a careful study of files.

Deadline for applications: Thursday, September 17, 2020 at the Léopold Sedar Senghor Chair of IRIC.

The tuition fees for the Master's degree is 650,000 FCA per year and the medical fees are 5,000 FCFA.

Career opportunities: apart from the numerous job opportunities, in particular putting their expertise at the service of Governments or International Organizations, the products of this Master's degree are also intended for enrolment in PhD programmes in all French Universities or in the French-speaking world, and beyond.
