- 8. A medical certificate issued within the last three (3) months by a medical doctor of a public health facility;
- 9. Four (04) passport size photographs (colour);
- 10. A photocopy of a valid National Identity Card or receipt;
- 11. A certificate of non-conviction issued within the last three (3) months;
- 12. A copy of the National Disability Card (for disabled persons);
- 13. A pledge of honour on: (i) the authenticity of the documents provided and (ii) the effective availability of the candidate.
